³³ When they came to the place called the Skull, they crucified Him there, along with the criminals—one on His right, the other on His left.

³⁴ Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.” And they divided up His clothes by casting lots.

³⁵ The people stood watching, and the rulers even sneered at Him. They said, “He saved others; let Him save Himself if He is God’s Messiah, the Chosen One.”

³⁶ The soldiers also came up and mocked Him. They offered Him wine vinegar ³⁷ and said, “If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself.”

³⁸ There was a written notice above Him, which read: THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.

³⁹ One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at Him: “Aren’t You the Messiah? Save Yourself and us!”

⁴⁰ But the other criminal rebuked him. “Don’t you fear God,” he said, “since you are under the same sentence?”

⁴¹ We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this Man has done nothing wrong.”

⁴² Then he said, “Jesus, remember me when You come into Your kingdom.”

⁴³ Jesus answered him, “Truly I tell you, today you will be with Me in paradise.”
