Exodus 1:15-21 (RSV)

¹⁵ Then the king of Egypt said to the Hebrew midwives, one of whom was named Shiph'rah and the other Pu'ah, ¹⁶ "When you serve as midwife to the Hebrew women, and see them upon the birthstool, if it is a son, you shall kill him; but if it is a daughter, she shall live." ¹⁷ But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but let the male children live.

¹⁸ So the king of Egypt called the midwives, and said to them, "Why have you done this, and let the male children live?" ¹⁹ The midwives said to Pharaoh, "Because the Hebrew women are not like the Egyptian women; for they are vigorous and are delivered before the midwife comes to them."

²⁰ So God dealt well with the midwives; and the people multiplied and grew very strong. ²¹ And because the midwives feared God He gave them families.
