

#### FROM PASTOR JORDAN'S DESK

Greetings,

As December begins, many of us can already feel the excitement of Christmas building. For some, the Christmas tree has already been up for a week or more. The lights are up, Christmas music fills the air, and our calendars begin to fill with the familiar rhythms and traditions we love.

To be honest, my decorations have been up for a couple of weeks, and I've already watched at least one Christmas movie.

It's natural to look forward to the joy of Christmas morning, to the gatherings, the meals, and the celebration of Christ's birth.

But before we rush to the manger, we have been invited into a different kind of season—Advent, a season of waiting, watching, and preparing.

Advent purposefully slows us down.

It asks us to pause long enough to recognize our deep need for the Savior whose coming we celebrate. It reminds us that God's promises often unfold slowly, sometimes quietly, and always in God's timing. Advent teaches us that holy anticipation is part of our faith—trusting that God is at work even when the fulfillment has not yet arrived.

As we journey together through this season, may Advent give us space to breathe, to pray, and to watch for the ways Christ is drawing near.


