From Pastor Jordan's Desk

Greetings,

It is my hope and prayer that you are all doing well! Not only are we entering a new month, but we are entering a new liturgical season. In February, we will be entering the season of Lent. For some of us, we are very familiar with Lent and are already thinking about how to best prepare our spirits.

However, some of us only know Lent as the time of year when we give up chocolate or coffee for forty days. So, we must ask ourselves the question, what even is Lent?

Lent is the forty days before Easter. It is a time of repentance, prayer, and self-reflection. As part of the Lenten season, some people will choose to give up something like coffee, chocolate, or social media.

The purpose of giving something up is not to focus on the item we have given up. The purpose of giving something up is that whenever we want what we have given up we can use that time as a form of prayer or self-reflection. For example, if we have chosen to give up coffee, each time we want to reach for the coffee pot we can take the time to say a quick prayer.

The same is true for those who choose to take something on instead of giving something up. Instead of giving up coffee, chocolate, or social media...someone may choose to wake up an extra fifteen minutes early to spend in the Word or in prayer.

There is no right or wrong way to spend Lent.

We can choose to give something up or we can choose to take something on during this Lenten season. However, the importance is not on what we do or don't do.

We can strive to not trip during Lent, but we are all human. There may be a time we reach for the coffee pot, make the coffee, and take a sip only to realize we have forgotten about how we gave up coffee for Lent.

The purpose is not to be perfect. It is to be present in this time of waiting and to spend time reflecting on ourselves.

It is my prayer this Lenten season that we can slow down and reflect on our walk with God.

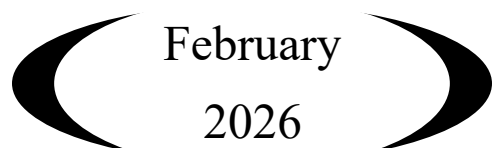
